The principles of Person Centered Planning/Thinking and Optimal Individual Service Design will be utilized.

The successful candidate will provide various services including employment, learning, and recreation with a focus on inclusion within various community based locations in the North Okanagan or as designated as part of various individual's service plans.

This position requires supporting the individuals in all areas of their lives including home, work, social recreation and the community.

May be required to provide 1:1 support for an individual who requires full support to participate in activities, needs personal care and has some behavioural challenges.
